

FQL

- SQL type language for Facebook APIs
- Helps to reduce the number of requests
- Helps to organize the request
- For ex: To retrieve names of all facebook friend ids for a user – “Sowmya”.

select name from user where uid IN (\$friendIds)

uid – user id for user Sowmya

\$friendIds – user ids for friends of Sowmya

concatenated by “,”

Facebook Login

- Call `Auth.createToken` to get a token from FB
- Generate a FB login url with which users enter their `uname/pwd`
- FB returns a session key once the user successfully both authenticates and authorizes One Social
- We will have to specify a call back url to which FB returns the session key via POST data
- Use this session key to make subsequent FB API calls
