## Automatic Installation

CDK for Windows has a small sample install script that can be used w/ InstallShield Professional (costs money)

To make your own need to use Conduit Manager API stored CondMgr.dll.

↑  
In same dir as Hotsync Manager executable

To find installed CondMgr.dll

easiest technique is to include your own copy of CondMgr w/ your program  
Look in standard/place list. If don't find  
Use your C# Get Core Path to find local copy.

If don't find install your copy.

to install

initial a CmConduitType object
