To switch from a given form to a new form we use the fⁿ

Note: \rightarrow Frm Goto Form (FormID of newForm),

this is for non-modal forms

\rightarrow this causes a FrmCloseEvent to be sent to the current form then send a FrmLoadEvent and a FrmOpenEvent to be sent to the new form

System's default fⁿ FrmHandleEvent automatically handles FrmCloseEvent's by erasing and disposing of Form

Your Application HandleEvent should handle FrmLoadEvents by initializing the form w/ FrmInitForm, then set the active form w/ FrmSetActiveForm, and finally associating an event handler for the form. w/ FrmSetEventHandler. Finally, the form should be drawn using FrmDrawForm.

If need to prompt user and a button response doesn't suffice probably should use a Modal form.
